Dear Residents and Interested Parties:

Since Monday, when we informed you of what to do with the debris, the County has come out with their agreement to assist the **unincorporated** areas with hauling. The alert sent by the County on Wednesday ***does not apply to the Town since we are an incorporated area.***

Republic Services had some difficulty with what was left at the curb Wednesday, which is supposed to be **no larger than 3" diameter and 4' lengths, and under 50 pounds**. What they found at the curb was more than an entire tree in some locations!

If you are a yard waste customer of Republic Services, they will pick up your yard waste as long as it meets the normal criteria of less than 3" in diameter.

If you have a large tree or branches that were damaged in the storm or you have far more debris than two men can handle placing in a garbage truck, you are responsible for the cutting and removal of these kinds of debris, not Republic Services. The Town recommends that you contact your lawn maintenance company to assist you.

This is what is posted on the Town website:

DEBRIS removal. Each development or gated community is responsible for its own disaster-generated debris removal. This is not reimbursable from FEMA. Neighborhood home/property owner associations must contract with a debris removal or landscaping company for additional assistance if necessary. The Town property and rights of ways are covered under our debris removal contract.

Residents who have yard waste removal with Republic Services must place **hurricane-related** yard debris along the roadway (no need to bundle, stack as usual *in no more than 3" diameter and 4' lengths*), and Republic will pick it up on your regularly scheduled yard waste pick up day. This applies to these neighborhoods:

- Pebble Bay Estates
- Indian Trails
- Marbrisa, Sea Forest
- Hidden Harbor (Amy Ann Lane)
- Sea Watch (Drive) and
- Village Shores.

It also applies to these non-gated streets:

- Beachcomber Lane
- Indian Lane, Reef Lane
- Pebble Lane, Seminole Lane
- Surf Lane, and
- Sunrise Terrace. The yard waste must be no more than 3" diameter and 4' lengths.

If you have **larger trees or branches** they **cannot** be hauled by Republic Services. Please arrange for transport to the [vegetative landfill](#) by some other means.

Do not put any vegetative debris on **State Road A1A**. It is **not being used as a staging area**.
