We regret to inform you that **red tide** has reached our coastline in Indian River Shores. Per the Department of Health in Indian River County, please follow these recommendations:

- People, especially those with respiratory issues, are encouraged to stay away from the beaches if possible for the next 2-10 days. This is not deadly to breathe the air, but you may suffer from the major impact of throat irritation and/or coughing.
- Higher wind or tides can spread it more quickly.
- Dead fish are not to be eaten! Be cautious with any fish caught from the southeastern coast of Florida.
- Do **not** consume shellfish of any kind caught in this area until it passes.
