Dear Residents and Interested Parties,

The **RED TIDE** tests from Round Island Beach Park, Sexton Plaza Beach Park, Wabasso Beach Park, and Sebastian Inlet State Park (South Side Beach) that were taken on Monday all show that **we are clear from the Red Tide!** All guarded public beaches with the exception of Tracking Station (still used for staging the cleanup) are open. The County hopes to complete one more pass next week for dead fish removal.

In other news:

- The **new recycling carts** are scheduled for **first use** next week. If you do not want to keep your old 18 gallon bin, please place it (empty) on top of your new cart next week. [This flyer](#) with **single stream** recycling Do's and Don'ts should have been attached to the cart. - Today, **October 31**, is the deadline for the Supervisors of Elections to receive requests for **vote by mail ballots** for the General Election on November 6. Please [visit this link](#), or stop by the Supervisor of Elections office before 4:30 p.m. at 4375 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue. Remember, **voting November 6<sup>th</sup>** will be at 7 am-7 pm at Christ by the Sea Methodist Church about a mile south of town on the right on A1A.
- The **FDOT Public Information and Input** meetings will be **tomorrow, November 1** at the Holiday Inn Oceanside from 10-12 or 4:30-6:30. Please [see this link](#) for full details.
- Since the Community Center normally hosts the Samaritan Center **Soup Bowl** for our area, please note that the closest location (still with the delicious Ed Schlitt Realtors' soups) will be held at the Bethel Creek House **tomorrow, November 1 from 11:30-1:30**.
