Dear Residents of Indian River Shores,

There is a **mandatory evacuation for residents of the barrier island. Please leave at your earliest convenience.**

- Updates *including shelter information* is on the [town website](#). Other sites to help you stay informed include [myfoxxhurricane.com](#), [Mike's Weather Page](#) (Melbourne), and [Indian River County Emergency Management](#) .
- **The weather may be nice Thursday morning, but is expected to rapidly deteriorate in the afternoon.**
- **Household waste** will be picked up as much as possible. If your garbage is missed Thursday, it will be picked up on Monday. If it is missed Friday, it will be picked up on Tuesday.
- **Town Hall** offices are closed until Monday. The **Postal Center** will reopen Tuesday.

IF YOU CHOOSE TO STAY, please be prepared to provide the information of your name, address, phone number, and next of kin to the **Public Safety Department at 231-2451, press zero.**

Be aware that the **Public Safety Officers are not able to leave the building** once wind speeds reach **60 mph**.
