## **RESOLUTION NO. 13-01**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN RIVER SHORES IN INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE PURCHASE AND SALE AGREEMENTS RELATED TO THE CITY OF VERO BEACH'S ELECTRIC UTILITY; AND ENCOURAGING THE CITY OF VERO BEACH VOTERS TO FAVORABLY CONSIDER THE MARCH 12, 2013 BINDING REFERENDUM FOR THE SALE OF THE ELECTRIC UTILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Indian River Shores has been a customer of the City of Vero Beach Utilities for electric service since 1968 and remains under the 1986 Agreement per Resolution 414; and

WHEREAS, the Town is currently well served by Florida, Power and Light (FPL) from Old Winter Beach Road northward; and

**WHEREAS,** the Town Council and residents are greatly in favor of being entirely serviced by FPL also in the southern portion of Town.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town of Indian River Shores in Indian River County, Florida that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Town Council of Indian River Shores unanimously supports the purchase and sale agreements related to the City of Vero Beach's electric utility.

<u>Section 2</u>. The Town Council of Indian River Shores hereby unanimously supports the acceptance by the registered voters of the City of Vero Beach in the March 12, 2013 referendum of the proposed purchase and sale agreements between FPL and the City of Vero Beach, Florida.

**Section 3**. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
