**RESOLUTION FOR ASSISTANCE 2016
UNDER THE FLORIDA INLAND NAVIGATION DISTRICT (FIND)
WATERWAYS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Town of Indian River Shores is interested in carrying out the following described project for the enjoyment of the citizenry of the Town and the State of Florida:

Project Title: Law Enforcement and Fire Suppression Patrol Boat

Total Estimated Cost: \$120,000

Brief Description of Project: Almost 30% of the area of Indian River Shores is covered by water. There are over 23 statute miles of patrol shoreline, both lagoon and ocean, as well as 5.4 miles of the Intra-Coastal Waterway (ICW) within the Public Safety Department's (PSD's) purview (see attachment E-9). In addition to the many hours on waterway safety and law enforcement patrol, the present boat has responded to almost 50 calls for assistance from the Indian River County dispatch (as Unit "Marine 41") including life-saving situations as far North as the Sebastian Inlet and as far South as Harbor Branch Oceanographic Institute.

The current boat, predominantly funded by FIND in FY 2000, has limited capability in surf/rough seas and no fire suppression capability. Anticipating this, the Town Council has included a line item in their 2016 budget towards partially funding a new boat.

AND, Florida Inland Navigation District financial assistance is required for the program mentioned above;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Indian River Shores that the project described above be authorized;

AND be it further resolved that said Town of Indian River Shores Public Safety Department make application to the Florida Inland Navigation District in the amount of 50% of the actual cost of the project in behalf of said Town of Indian River Shores Public Safety Department;

AND be it further resolved by the Town of Indian River Shores Public Safety Department that it certifies to the following:

1. That it will accept the terms and conditions set forth in FIND Rule 66B-2 F.A.C. and which will be a part of the Project Agreement for any assistance awarded under the attached proposal.
2. That it is in complete accord with the attached proposal and that it will carry out the Program in the manner described in the proposal and any plans and specifications attached thereto unless prior approval for any change has been received from the District.
3. That it has the ability and intention to finance its share of the cost of the project and that the project will be operated at the expense of said Town of Indian River Shores Public Safety Department for public use.
4. That it will not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, color or national origin in the use of any property or facility acquired or developed pursuant to this proposal, and shall comply with the terms and intent of the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, P.L. 88-352 (1964) and design and construct all facilities to comply fully with statutes relating to

accessibility by persons with disabilities as well as other federal, state and local laws, rules and requirements.

5. That it will maintain adequate financial records on the proposed project to substantiate claims for reimbursement.
6. That it will make available to FIND if requested, a post-audit of expenses incurred on the project prior to, or in conjunction with, request for the final 10% of the funding agreed to by FIND.
