NOTICE OF PROPOSED INCREASE IN WATER, WASTEWATER,
IRRIGATION, AND REUSE RATES
TO BE PAID
BY INDIAN RIVER SHORES RESIDENTS

The City of Vero Beach, which supplies water, wastewater, and reuse water services to all residents of the Town of Indian River Shores, is considering revisions to these rates. The table below is supplied by the City to illustrate the impact of proposed rates increases for a customer that uses 4,000 gallons a month.
